<u>Call for Nominations for the 2018 ACS Puget Sound Section</u> <u>Executive Officers</u>

The ACS Puget Sound Section is calling for nominations for its executive committee elections for offices starting in January 2018. We have seven positions up for election and we would love your contributions to the continued success of our section. A brief description of the duties for each position is provided below.

Section Chair-Elect/Chair/Past-Chair (1 Year Term per Position - One open position)

This is a three year commitment serving one year as Chair-Elect, Chair, and Past-Chair. The duties vary slightly with each. Chair-Elect is the open position for 2018.

Chair-Elect (2018) Responsibilities

- attend executive committee meetings and facilitate meetings in the chair's absence
- head the speakers' bureau committee
- attend the Leadership Institute training sponsored by ACS

Chair (2019) Responsibilities

- lead executive committee meetings and provide leadership
- appoint committee chairs
- ensure timely completion of business tasks

Past-Chair (2020) Responsibilities

- attend executive committee meetings
- provide support to the Chair, Chair-Elect, and the executive committee
- complete annual report for previous year
- lead the nominating committee

Secretary (1 Year Term - One open position for 2018)

Secretary's Responsibilities

- taking and distributing notes at executive committee meetings
- create and manage election ballot and work with election Tellers to validate election results
- submit the election results and committee nomination to the national office

Treasurer (1 Year Term - One open position for 2018)

Treasurer's Responsibilities

- prepare a monthly budget and manage the section's accounts
- manage cash inflows and outflows
- work with the finance committee to review the section's finances and prepare the annual budget
- complete the financial section of the annual report.

Councilor (3 Year Term - Two open positions for 2018-2020)

Councilor's Responsibilities

- represent the section at the two National meetings and serve on national committees
- advise the chair, the executive committee and other committee chairs
- volunteer or be assigned to serve on section committees and subcommittees

Alternate Councilor (3 Year Term – Two open positions for 2018-2020)

Alternate Councilor's Responsibilities

- fulfill the role of a councilor when the councilor is not available
- attend the regional NORM meeting
- volunteer or be assigned to serve on section committees and subcommittees.
